



# Mrs Flowerpot's



## Super Chunky Cable Scarf

### You will need:

4 x 100g balls of super bulky acrylic yarn for a 165cm/65" long scarf

10mm knitting needles

A thick cable needle (or a wooden pencil sharp on both ends)

### Abbreviations:

K knit

P purl

C6F place 3 stitches onto cable needle and hold in front of work, knit next 3 stitches then knit 3 stitches from cable needle.



### To make the scarf:

Cast on 18 stitches.

Row 1: K6, P6, K6.

Row 2: Knit to end.

Row 3: K6, P6, K6.

Row 4: Knit to end.

Row 5: K6, P6, K6.

Row 6: K6, C6F, K6.

These 6 rows form the pattern. Repeat these 6 rows until the scarf is the desired length. End after row 3. Cast off.  
Weave in ends.
